FROM THE MANAGER'S DESK

"Will I ever get Fiber?"

It's a question that the co-op employees hear every day. While fiber is better, it is only better if you need higher speeds than what we cannot deliver on copper.

Some of the questions we ask our patrons... Why do you need fiber? Do you need more speed? Are you streaming television services across the Internet, such as Netflix, hulu or YouTube? Do you game? Do you have kids who have many connected devices? How many connected devices do you have in your home? What speed are you needing: 6 Meg, 10 Meg, 20 Meg, 50 Meg, 100 Meg or 1 Gig. Unless you need speeds 100 Meg or higher, we can most likely get you bandwidth up to 50 Meg now (depending on the resources to your location).

As you have heard me speak before, funding once allocated to furnish the co-op with a fiber network was eliminated for approximately 75% of our co-op due to false information provided by a competitor in their filings to the government. This hurt us bad, about 27 million dollars bad. That's a lot of money, but it would take that much to build our rural network. But while patience is a virtue, time is not on our side. Time that does not exist when folks want it yesterday. So, we realized that it was going to take longer or we would not be able to do it all with the loss of this funding.

So, we looked and found alternative technology solutions that has been developed over the last few years with the ability to squeeze a little more bandwidth through our copper network. We actually thought we were done with the copper but we have once again breathed a little more life into the network giving it a second wind.

We now offer higher broadband speeds but it does take a little bit of work and expense to line condition a copper loop to your location. And not everyone is a candidate, but we will do everything we can to meet your needs. The question now is, is it available in your area? Each location is different, each location has its own set of physical characteristics that have to be addressed to qualify it for delivery of a DSL line adequate to provide a higher broadband speed service.

So, will I ever get fiber? At this time this is hard to answer, however give us a call and let us know if you need more bandwidth. We will do our best to find a solution best for you.
