Mozilla Thunderbird

Once you have downloaded and installed Thunderbird on to your machine, you can follow these steps to set up your pair email:

- 1. Open the Thunderbird application
- 2. On the main page, under the **Set up an account** heading, click **Email**



This page will come up automatically for new users and some existing users. If this page does not come up default, you can click **Local Folders** in the left sidebar to navigate to the page.
