#### to unwanted telemarketing calls.

Are you tired of those unwanted telemarketing calls? Then get your number on the National Do Not Call Registry List. It's easy, here's how:

1) Call 1-888-382-1222. Choose your language (English = 1; Spanish = 2). To add your number to the registry, press 1. When prompted, enter your 10-digit telephone number.

2) Go to www.donotcall.gov; click on Register Now button and enter telephone information.

The National Do Not Call Registry gives you a choice about whether to receive telemarketing calls at home. Most telemarketers should not call your number once it has been on the registry for 31 days. If they do, you can file a complaint at this website. You can register your home or mobile phone for free.

#### Managed Wi-Fi

The Co-op and its subsidiaries introduced Managed Wi-Fi a couple of years ago. This is a service we now provide to help optimize your home's bandwidth and wireless needs.

With this service, you will receive a commercial grade router that provides more penetration throughout your home to provide a greater customer wi-fi experience. This router allows more throughput than the traditional wireless router. Furthermore, this plan also includes an extender when needed. Additionally, we can now troubleshoot any wi-fi issues you might be having over the phone. The equipment we provide remains the property of the Co-op and therefore, there are costly up front expenses or replacement costs.

Anyone with our internet service can subscribe to our Managed Wi-Fi for \$9.99/month. For more information, call our office at 618-736-2211.
