We want to remind everyone that the safest way to shop is to shop with people or stores that you know and are familiar with. Shopping LOCAL is not only the fastest way to shop, but also the most safe and secure option available.

However, we know there will be a lot of online shopping done this season, and as your internet provider, we want to share some tips for secure online shopping.

Some top threats to be aware of are:

- ~ Be cautious of malicious websites or bogus email messages.
- ~ Vendors or stores who do not properly secure their online system may allow an attacker to intercept your information.
- ~ Make sure your digital device is updated and protected before entering your information through it.

How to protect yourself:

- ~ Make sure you are interacting with a reputable and well known vendor.
- ~ Make sure the address bar begins with "https:" and that it has a padlock icon. These are indicators that you are interacting with a secure website/vendor.
- ~ Do not provide any account information and payment information through email.
- ~ Try to use a credit card instead of a debit card for purchases, limiting your liability for fraudulent charges. Another option is to use an online payment service like PayPal, Venmo or Google Wallet.
- ~ Always compare your purchases to your bank or credit card statements.
- ~ Before providing your personal or financial information, check the website's privacy policy to understand the storage and use of your information.
- ~ Be smart about apps. Apps make everything more convenient, including stealing your private information. Only download apps from reliable sources like Apple or Google Play and pay attention to the permissions that the app asks for.

When considering to authorize capital credits, you need to be aware just how critical it is that the board exercise its full fiduciary responsibility in reviewing the co-op's capability based on expected funding shortfalls.

Right now, the Co-op is investing every dollar back into our plant to expand our fiber construction within the Co-op. Although this is great for securing the future of our Co-op, it does mean that there will not be any Capital Credit checks again this year. Estate payouts may also be limited. Ingredients

-12 ounces white baking chocolate, chopped

- -1 package (1 pound) Nutter Butter sandwich cookies
- -Red colored sugar
- -32 vanilla or white chips
- -64 miniature semisweet chocolate chips
- -32 Red Hots candies

Directions

In a microwave, melt white chocolate at 70% power for 1 minute; stir. Microwave at additional 10- to 20-second intervals, uncovered. Place on wire racks.

stirring until smooth.

Dip one end of each cookie into melted chocolate, allowing excess to drip off. Place on wire racks. For Santa's hat, sprinkle red sugar on top part of chocolate. Press one vanilla chip off-center on hat for pompom; let stand until set. Dip other end of each cookie into melted chocolate for beard, leaving center of cookie

With a dab of melted chocolate, attach semisweet chips for eyes and a Red Hot for nose. Place on waxed paper until set.
